

Production Quality Auditor Level II

This position is an intermediate level Quality Control Auditor requiring math and problem solving skills to a high school education, with course work in metrics and 2+ years of this type work history. Under limited supervision this auditor must be able to perform diversified bench or floor inspection of a variety of standard or custom parts, products or materials that are being produced in house or received from vendors. Will use a variety of precision measuring instruments including electronic devices. To be successful in this role, the right person must be proficient in checks for color, finish, dimensions, hardness, density or other measurable or observable characteristics of material. Will also perform detailed first article inspections following the installation of new or revised molds and dies. The Production Quality Auditor II may recommend, write or modify sampling and inspection procedures as well as use statistical tools to chart variances.

About This New Position: Is required to train in, learn and become competent and proficient in the general quality department skilled areas of;

- Competency and proficiency in first piece evaluations, weld inspection, audits of paint line at various operations as defined and required by control plans. May work with Production Supervisors, Area Leads and/or the Production Manager to verify JOST Work Instructions are being followed and operator inspection sheets filled out, as required by control plans.
- Work within JOST Quality Policies & Objectives to include access and solid working knowledge of JOST Quality Records, and System Documents.
- Process and containment activities of non-conforming
- Ability to read, understand the JOST part number structure as well as use/process correctly; shop math, gages and calibration, basic blueprint reading, part layout.
- Process, and competency of; Temporary ECN's (TECN), Quality Alerts, Engineering releases, Deviations, and ECN's and similar related, timely.
- Ensures that paperwork is completed, product meets customer order requirements, and product conforms to print, as called from control plan.
- Solid computer skills with advanced proficiency in spreadsheets, formulas, charting and graphing as well as working knowledge in AS400 and ERP/MRP systems and other as related.
- Working proficiency in GD&T.
- Ability in hand welded deviation layout and approval from established fixture. Is required to train in, learn and become competent and proficient in the Process Audits to the Control Plans.
 - Provides production support to include but not limited to; Final assembly audit, assembly process audit, destructive testing, weld crush test.
 - Receiving inspections/audits and shipping inspection/audit. (part correct, quantity correct, completed paperwork, correct to order)
 - Small parts and kitting validation audits.
 - Capable to perform; Weld penetration testing, material hardness testing, destructive testing (cushion foot push out), product testing (AAR lifecycle), elevation nut testing for perpendicularity.
- Audit and evaluate product from assembly and weld operations. Conveys information pertaining to supervisors.
- Assist in processing of scrap and/or returns to/from vendors, as required/directed.
- Training and certification required in; Hobart Welding Course; Advanced Blueprint Reading Training/Certification, GD&T Training/Certification, Gage R&R Training. Industry and JOST

Specification – Standards; JOST White Belt Training Certification; APQP and Control Plan Training. ASQ CQI Certified Quality Inspector Testing and Certification.

- Ability to gain knowledge of reading blueprints.
