Intern Wanted for Area Farmers Markets and Department of Public Health Programs

Grand Haven & Spring Lake Farmers Market and Ottawa County Department of Public Health are seeking an intern for the Spring and Summer of 2017. The combined position focuses on two programs: Prescription for Health, and Power of Produce (POP) Kids Club which are available at the *Grand Haven Farmers Market* and *Spring Lake Farm & Garden Market*.

Prescription for Health is a collaborative program that increases access to healthy foods for individuals at the Farmers Markets. POP Kids Club is a program for kids that encourages healthy eating habits.

The Intern will be required to be at the Farmers Markets on Saturdays starting in May, along with Wednesdays and Thursdays starting in June through August. This position also provides support to the Market Manager during the Farmers Markets and will require hours in the office. This internship is available for college credit only.
