

## **Warner Norcross Now Accepting Applications for Minority Scholarships, Designed to Assist Students with Legal Studies**

**Holland, Michigan, Jan. 29, 2018** – Warner Norcross + Judd is now accepting applications for two of its scholarship programs designed to assist minority students with legal studies: The Minority Scholarship Program and the LSAT Preparation Course Scholarship Program.

Now in its 18th year, the Minority Scholarship program annually provides monetary assistance to students to aid with the educational costs associated with earning a law or paralegal degree. Applications are due April 1 and winners will be selected by the Grand Rapids Community Foundation.

In its 11th year, the LSAT Preparation Course Scholarship Program awards two minority students each with a scholarship to attend a Kaplan LSAT preparation course, which consists of 10 sessions and provides winners with a head-start on preparation for the Law School Admissions Test. Studies show those who take the prep course score higher on the test, which determines law school entrance.

Applications are due April 30.
