



SOLDER Associate

Job Description

1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE:

The Solder Associate is responsible for producing and soldering quality parts and meeting the ontime completion expectations of their Production Lead or Assistant Lead.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Build and solder quality products as assigned
- Ensure on-time completion of products assigned
- · Accountable for job set-up
- Must ensure that all paperwork for the assigned job is correct
- Make certain that DBA Labor Timesheet is filled out correctly and turned in each day
- Provide on-the-job assistance to new Solder Associates as directed by Production Lead or Assistant Lead
- · Attend production related classes, which includes IPC classes
- Attend solder related classes, which includes J-STD classes
- · Promote team building
- · Clean work area at the end of the day

3. EDUCATION and TRAINING:

The Solder Associate is required, as a minimum, to have a high school diploma or GED equivalent. The Production Manager and the Human Resource Manager can determine whether education and training are "equivalent" based on their experience.

4. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT:

Use and knowledge of a ruler is essential. Hot Iron knowledge is a must for soldering.

5. EXPERIENCE:

Work knowledge of wire harness processing is preferred.

Past work history of soldering wires to components and tin dipping a must for soldering.

How to Advance:

Those who advance are asked to contact a designated Temporary Employment Agency to start the Pre-Employment Testing (drug and vision test). Start dates are almost immediate pending results. Successful candidates who demonstrate good performance and attendance may be hired in directly at GlobalTec within the first 30 days of employment whereby he/she will become eligible for our competitive benefit plan within 60 days of direct employment as well as many other employment benefits (gainshare, profit share, 401K, 10 Paid Holidays).
