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## **Grand Haven Students to Participate in Nature-Based Learning Experience**

**GRAND HAVEN, MI** – <u>Grand Haven Area Public Schools (GHAPS)</u> is partnering with the ODC Network, also known as the Outdoor Discovery Center, to bring a three-week, nature-based learning experience to students. The collaboration was made possible by the Grand Haven Area Community Foundation and supports the district's project-based learning efforts.

White Elementary and in Duncan Woods, where students will engage with the local habitat and learn what makes their own backyard unique. During their time with the ODC Network, they will interact with the environment through observations and hands-on activities. Students will experience a range of activities, including interactive read alouds, animal encounters, building fairy gardens and more.

"Our main objective is to create positive and engaging experiences for every child outside of the classroom and in nature," said Carter. "Every student learns differently. For some students, getting them out of a classroom setting gives them the opportunity to thrive as class leaders."
